STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

A. Purpose

The purpose of the Green Team is to advise the Board of Selectmen and Town Manager and other Town boards in the development of environmental criteria for all town projects. The Green Team will provide the necessary review of (1) existing and proposed practices and (2) of projects proposed for public property, to ensure that the Town has considered energy and resource conservation as well as other sustainable practices in the construction of new facilities and in the carrying-out of other Town functions. The Green Team will also function as an ecological community resource for private citizens, and as an information clearinghouse with regard to issues of sustainable design and planning.

B. Membership

The Committee's core group consists of David Bearg, indoor air quality engineer; Richard Keleher, architect; Paul Kirshen, professor, water resources engineering and management; Lawrence Masland, advisor on energy efficiency and renewable energy policy; Michael McAteer, building lighting advisory consultant; Peter Nobile, architect; Andrew Proulx and Sergio Siani, mechanical engineers; John Bolduc, environmental planner; James Catterton, planner.

The Green Team has formed two subcommittees:

- 1) Sustainable building and community design and planning review
- 2) General environmental practices review and policy development for the Town of Concord

A. Background

The Green Team advised the School Building Committee on the implementation of the Master Plan, leading up to the 2001 Town Meeting.

We have since worked on the Harvey Wheeler Community Center and the Police and Fire Stations and have been on the CCHS Planning Committee and the CPS Facilities Planning Committee.
